LINCS owns a 30 thousand square foot state of the art office building that provides professional office space to partnering and other non-profit agencies. This uniquely designed building allows non-profits to compete in the professional arena.

LINCS provides office space to BiasHELP and LIAAC and administrative functions designed to enhance organizational efficiency including:
